The City of Canton, hereinafter known as the Owner, is inviting sealed Bid Proposals from interested and qualified parties for the Canton Opera House Site Improvements. This project consists of new construction of the following:

- Custom concrete entry arch (Coordination Only)
- Custom concrete columns and seat walls (Coordination Only)
- Custom aluminum arches (Coordination Only)
- Custom ornamental fencing (Coordination Only)
- ADA concrete sidewalks & ramps
- ADA colored concrete sidewalks
- Band Shell building with a raised concrete stage. The building includes a storage and concessions room. Power and water services will be provided for the band shell building.
- Concrete steps and railings
- Band Shell loading dock
- Lighting for the band shell and plaza
- Dog watering bowl
- New storm sewer system
- Providing water to the site
- Plaza lighting system
- Plant material & sod
- Irrigation system

Bids for this work shall include all labor, supervision, materials, supplies, transportation, tools/equipment, and services necessary and required to perform the work as set forth in the Contract Documents.

Main St. Canton, Illinois 61520, prior to 10:00 am on October 25, 2024. **The Bid Opening itself will be held at the Canton Historic Depot located at 50 N. Fourth Ave. on October 25th at 10:00 am.** which time the bids will be publicly opened and read aloud. No bid shall be withdrawn for thirty (30) days after the opening of the bids without consent of the Owner.

A **Pre-Bid Conference** will be scheduled for October 11, 2024 @10:00 am at 2 N. Main Street in the Directors Room, Canton Illinois 61520. Representatives of all bidding firms are encouraged to attend to present any questions they may have. Neither the Architect nor the Owner will respond to questions orally regarding the Project outside the Pre-Bid Conference. Minutes of the Pre-Bid Conference will be disseminated to all bidder through the architect's bidding website. All requests for clarifications or interpretations outside the Pre-Bid Conference shall be made to the Architect and will be answered by Addendum when appropriate.
