

A Message from the Spoon River Partnership for Economic Development (SRPED)...



Fulton County Small Business COVID-19 Relief Grant

On Tuesday, February 8th the Fulton County Board approved for SRPED to administer a \$700,000 grant program for small businesses negatively impacted by the COVID-19 Pandemic, for all of Fulton County and its' business owners. Applications for the FCSBG program will be available, along with the FAQ Sheet, Program Overview, and Eligibility Guidelines on Monday, February 15th, both at our offices at 48 N. Main St. and online at cantonillinois.org.

Grant will range from \$2,500 - \$50,000, and applications will be made available Monday, February 15th, both on the cantonillinois.org website and in hard copy at 48 N. Main St. in Canton. Please contact Cole McDaniel at the Spoon River Partnership for Economic Development at 309-573-1422 or by email at

cmcdaniel@cantonillinois.org to determine eligibility and apply. Technical Assistance Sessions will be held throughout Fulton County starting with one in Canton in late February hosted by SRPED and CACC. More details on the technical assistance meetings will be forthcoming.

I would encourage anyone who would like to apply or to know more about the program, reach out to me to schedule an appointment as soon as possible. This program will help to assist those business owners that are still struggling from the COVID-19 Pandemic, that have received the least amount of grant assistance from other Federal and State Programs.

I want to personally thank the Fulton County Board and Elected Officials for supporting this program from its first introduction 4 months ago. The support for the business community from our local leaders all over the county has been vital to our ability to remain resilient, and isn't something you can find just anywhere. Thank you to all that were involved with helping move this program forward.


